Why College Advantage?

St. John's University is committed to providing all eager students with academic advantages as early as possible.

The **College Advantage Program** at St. John's provides qualifying high school juniors and seniors with the opportunity to enroll concurrently in high school and credit bearing St. John's courses at a cost of \$325 per course, a deep discount from regular undergraduate tuition rates.

Classes are taught at your high school by approved teachers in areas of study that include English, mathematics, language, fine arts, science, social sciences, and humanities.

College Advantage students who enroll at St. John's University the semester after high school graduation receive a **\$2,000 Tuition Grant** per year for up to four years of continuous, full-time undergraduate study at St. John's.

Application Information

In order to participate in the College Advantage Program, vetted students will:

- Submit a St. John's College Advantage **online application**
- After the application is submitted, St. John's will **verify courses** selected on the application
- Once courses are verified, St. John's will **register the student** for the selected College Advantage courses
- After course registration, **St. John's will issue both electronic and paper bills** (both will be sent to the contact information provided on the online application)
- Both the electronic and paper bills will contain instructions regarding **how to submit payment**
